As the South Bend Community School Corporation prepares for the 2020-21 school year, we are requesting feedback from any families who wish to pursue eLearning or change their transportation plans due to the COVID-19 pandemic.

**All** students in the corporation (both in-person learning and eLearning students) will begin with eLearning on **August 12**; those who choose in-person learning will gradually phase into physical school buildings later in August. If your student(s) plans to continue with eLearning exclusively (when other students return to in-person learning on **August 31\***) please indicate [enrollment here](#). We recommend that families that select this option remain with eLearning for at least the first marking period to ensure continuity of instruction.
